

PPN2016 – YSS, 15-17 September 2016 Wrocław, Poland

Call for full papers

All registered participants would have an opportunity to submit full texts of their presentations to a special post-conference section within future issues of *Acta Poloniae Pharmaceutica – Drug Research* .

Instructions for authors

All submissions must be prepared according to the journal requirements and will be subject to full peer review including preliminary qualification by the Scientific Committee. The manuscripts should be sent directly to the PPN Organizers (ppn2016@mailplus.pl) before the deadline which is on 31st October 2016. Expected publication time will be first half of 2017 (depending on the publisher's processing capacity).

The corresponding author of the manuscript must be a registered participant of the PPN 2016 Symposium. Only one submission per registered participant is allowed, and it must contain the subject matter presented during the PPN 2016 Symposium.

The article processing fee payable before publication for the accepted article is 600 PLN (150 EUR) payable to the same conference accounts that were used for registration fees.

To support early stage researchers publication record, the article processing fee will be waived for corresponding authors who were registered as students (including PhD students), and are at the same time FIRST authors of the article.

The review articles are generally discouraged. If the participant intends to submit a review paper, it must be preceded by a cover letter convincingly indicating the suitability and scientific soundness of the subject matter.

The manuscripts must be prepared as Word documents (preferably as .docx files). entire submission should be contained in a single file. We can also accept Open Office files but the Authors may be requested to change the format if the files are not properly opening or converting. PDF files are not accepted during submission.

The experimental/research article should consist of following sections:

Title Page:

Article title (in bold)

Full names of all authors (given names first, then surnames)

Affiliations with mailing addresses (no phone/fax numbers please) and e-mails of all authors. Use English names of institutions, but do not translate local street addresses and city names (for example, do use 'ul. Borowska' and NOT 'Borowska Str.', and Warszawa, not Warsaw). For countries where non-Latin alphabets are used, use Latin transliteration.

indicate corresponding author's name by an asterisk *Name Surname. For co-authors and multiple affiliations use superscript numerals to indicate the institution.

Abstract

No longer than 400 words. No references are allowed in the abstract. It should contain all important information, including the results and conclusions.

key words: up to five key words different from those used in the title;

1) Introduction,

2) Experimental,

3) Results,

4) Discussion and conclusion(s)

optionally: Acknowledgements

Authors contributions

5) References

The authors should pay effort to provide concise research manuscripts, preferably not exceeding 6000 words (excluding title, authors, affiliations abstract and reference list), four tables, four figures, and 30 references. These limits can be exceeded only if absolutely inevitable without compromising the scientific soundness. In all other cases, the Authors of an excessively long paper may be asked to reduce the length of the article before peer review.

For Short Communications, use the same style, but limit the length of the paper to 2000 words (using built-in word count function of a text editor) and a maximum of 15 References, two tables and one figure. The Editors reserve the right to publish (upon agreement of Author(s) as a Short Communication a paper originally submitted as a full-length research paper.

Tables should not have more than 70, and certainly not more than 140 characters to the line (counting spaces between columns 4 characters) unless absolutely unavoidable. In the original submission, embed all tables and figures in the manuscripts text. However, the submission file size should be kept below 5 MB, so avoid big size images. The separate, high resolution image files would be requested if the reviewer(s) wish to see them, and after accepting decision.

Citations in the originally submitted text should follow a Harvard-type referencing [Zielinski et al. 2015, Johnson & Johnson 2016], the multiple citations should appear chronologically from the earliest to the latest. For those with the same publishing year, use alphabetical order. Do not use the *Acta Poloniae Pharmaceutica – Drug Research* referencing style at this step because it makes the peer review tedious.

References must be all cited in the text and listed alphabetically using any format, but must contain initials and names of all authors followed by year of publication, full title of the article/book/chapter, source (journal in full name (do not use abbreviated journal names at this step of submission!), including volume number (issue number is optional) and page numbers. For chapters, a full title and authors of source book/monograph must be listed followed by the publisher and place of issue.

For Internet sources/databases, full URL must be cited followed by the day of accessing. If an on-line source has a distinct name (such as “Plants for a Future Database” etc.), this name has to be cited, too.

Using/re-using copyrighted material is generally discouraged. If necessary, it is a sole responsibility of the Authors to secure and provide all required permissions from copyright holders.

The authors of an accepted manuscripts will be then requested to provide a file with full version formatted according to the requirements of *Acta Poloniae Pharmaceutica – Drug Research* such as font size and style, page size and margins, paragraph spacing etc. It would also need an adjustment of citation format and list of references as well as providing high resolution images and other graphics. This final pre-proof formatting will be required only for ACCEPTED manuscripts, within two weeks after sending the Editor’s decision to the Authors. However, if the Authors fail to provide the properly formatted files timely, the publication of the paper may not be possible.
